KEEP TEAM PLAYERS CYBER SAFE



RESEARCH SHOWS THAT OVER 50% OF ALL STUDENTS HAVE BEEN BULLIED USING SOME SOURCE OF SOCIAL MEDIA. IT CAN LEAD TO ANXIETY, DEPRESSION AND EVEN SUICIDE AS CHILDREN AND TEENS WILL RARELY VOLUNTEER TO TELL THEIR PARENTS ABOUT BEING A VICTIM OF CYBER-BULLYING.

- ★ The first step parents can take in creating a safe online world for their children is simply by having a conversation with them about it. Make sure they know that you are aware of the issues and dangers of cyber bullying. Ask if they have ever been bullied online.
- ★ Use parental controls and restrictions on every device, set rules and expectations, and monitor all social media accounts.
- ★ Set non-instructional screen-time limits in your home, as recommended by pediatricians, educators and health professionals
- ★ Be aware of changes in behavior, inability to concentrate, or drops in school grades and participation. They can be signs of a child being bullied.
- ★ Ask your "team member" school counselor for assistance, if needed.




DCHS Band
